The nearest station, Unoke Station, can be reached by walking (20 minutes) or by taxi (5 minutes). During the three days of the event, a shuttle bus (free of charge) will be provided at the schedule below. Feel free to make use of it if the schedule suits you (the bus departs from the Main East exit of Unoke Station, where the bronze statue of Nishida Kitaro stands. The number of seats is limited, so we apologize in advance in case the bus is fully occupied).
